

RESOLUTION NO. 2009-07

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CITY STAFF TO PLACE STOP SIGNS ON FIRETREE AVENUE AT THE INTERSECTION OF FIRETREE AVENUE & FLAME WAY IN ORDER TO ENHANCE THE SAFETY OF PEDESTRIANS IN THE NEIGHBORHOOD

WHEREAS, the City of Baldwin City has received a petition signed by numerous residents, largely from the Firetree Estates development, regarding traffic at the intersection of Firetree Avenue and Flame Way; and

WHEREAS, such traffic is perceived as a hazard, particularly when children and students are present at the intersection for the purposes of a school bus stop and accessing the Firetree Park; and

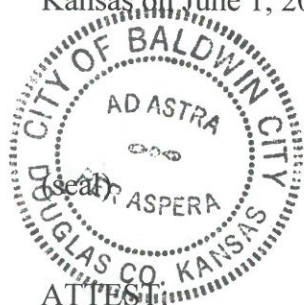
WHEREAS, the neighborhood has asked that traffic controls including a "4-Way Stop" and other signage indicating children playing in the area be installed at or near the intersection of Firetree Avenue and Flame Way to make it safe for pedestrians, specifically children; and

WHEREAS, the Safety Committee recommended that such intersection be controlled at all four points in order to enhance the safety of pedestrians.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BALDWIN CITY:

- Section 1. City Staff is authorized to place stop signs on Firetree Avenue at the intersection of Firetree Avenue and Flame Way in order to enhance the safety of pedestrians using that intersection to access a school bus stop and the Firetree Park.
- Section 2. Said intersection shall be controlled as a "4-way Stop" and is enforceable as such by law enforcement.


