A RESOLUTION INSTITUTING PARKING RESTRICTIONS IN THE 600 BLOCK OF DEARBORN STREET

WHEREAS, the governing body's Public Safety Committee has discussed parking, traffic, and emergency accessibility issues in relation to Baker University's Living & Learning Center located on the north side of the 600 block of Dearborn Street; and

WHEREAS, certain measures by the city would be useful in the interest of public safety regarding parking, pedestrians, traffic, and emergency accessibility issues; and


WHEREAS, the Public Safety Committee recommends the passage of parking restrictions within 600 block of Dearborn Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF BALDWIN CITY, KANSAS:


- Section 1. Parking shall be prohibited on both the north and south sides of the 600 block of Dearborn Street.
- Section 2. The "No Parking" zone described above shall be clearly marked with appropriately placed "No Parking" signs. Yellow curb paint may also be used to help designate the "No Parking" zone.
